As part of a national initiative to improve barrier-free access to hospitals and polyclinics, we are pleased to share with you that the installation of lifts at the Pedestrian Overhead Bridge across the AYE linking to the National University Hospital (NUH) has been completed. This is especially beneficial to patients, seniors and friends who are less mobile as it enables them to travel independently to their medical appointments.

At the Parliament Sitting in January 2022, I shared in support the Motion on Singapore's transition towards a low-carbon economy. I suggested reviewing employability gaps for undergraduates, and greater integration of sustainability-focused courses across all Institutes of Higher Learning, specifically through our Pre-Employment Training (PET) as well as Continuing Education and Training (CET) Efforts to boost undergraduate employment rates in green sectors.
