NEW JURONG REGION LINE

FASTER AND MORE CONVENIENT TRAVEL OPTIONS FOR WEST COAST GRC AND PIONEER SMC RESIDENTS

Travel options for West Coast GRC and Pioneer SMC residents will go up by several notches in the near future. The Jurong Region Line (JRL) will offer them more comfort and convenience and faster speed, with destination choices that will fetch them to practically the whole of Singapore. Yes, the JRL is creating a lot of buzz among residents and businesses in the Western part of the city.

Giving an example of the benefits, MP for West Coast GRC (Ayer Rajah), Ms Foo Mee Har said, “Upon completion of JRL, Ayer Rajah residents will be able to reach Jurong East station (two stations away) in approximately 5 minutes as compared to the 15 minutes when travelling by bus. From Jurong East, they will be able to transfer to the North-South and East-West Line.”

Ms Foo added: “JRL will be located along Jurong Town Hall Road, on the Teban Gardens plot of empty land vacated by the previous SERS blocks, with connections to Pandan Gardens and entrance/exits near Commonwealth Secondary School.”

“There will be 24 stations along JRL, serving Choa Chu Kang, Boon Lay and future developments at Tengah. It will connect residents to high activity areas in Jurong West including NTU, Jurong Industrial Estate and Jurong Island.

Mr Patrick Tay, MP for West Coast GRC (Boon Lay), in sharing the good news, said that three new stations would be located in the Boon Lay vicinity. They will be adjacent to Jurong JC, Boon Lay Meadow-Grove Estate, and Jurong West part of Boon Lay Division. They will be operational by 2026. Mr Tay added: “Glad to share that noise barriers and sheltered walkways will be built together with mobility paths to connect the various parts of our estate to these three stations.”

MP for Pioneer Constituency, Mr Cedric Foo, also shared that “travel times will be reduced by 15mins from Boon Lay MRT Station to NTU. Residents will have an alternative train route from Boon Lay to Choa Chu Kang MRT Station. Residents who are travelling to places of worship such as Masjid Maarof and Duo Tian Gong Temple along Jurong West Avenue 4 will have direct rail service at Bahar Junction. Students in NTU and NSMen will also have direct rail services to their destinations.”



THE HEROIC FIVE WHO SAVED CARDIAC ARREST VICTIM

Thanks to the quick-thinking action of five people, a man who suffered a cardiac arrest at the void deck of Block 653 Jurong West Street 61 on February 24, was saved.

Three grassroots leaders from Pioneer Division were at a Residents' Committee event in the vicinity when they heard

of the collapsed man from Ms Selina Hui, 38, an auditor with Pioneer Zone 12 RC and her daughter Rensise Lim, 6.


Mr Goh Keh Wee, Pioneer Zone 12 RC Chairman and West Coast Town Council Councillor, and Mr Cheong Sun Tze (Jackson) and Mr Gregory Ng, a performer at the event, rushed to a nearby block to retrieve an automated external defibrillator (AED).

The group used the AED, which works by sending an electric shock to the heart in order to revive it and performed cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) on the victim Mr Lau Hung Khim, 52. Soon his heart started beating and he was breathing once more. An ambulance took him to hospital. Mr Lau, a taxi driver, who has since recovered from the ordeal, said he was thankful to be saved. He added: "I am extremely grateful to the lifesavers who helped me. Their efforts not only allow me to live but also preserved my family's happiness."

The five were presented the Community Lifesaver Awards on 14 March 2018 at the Bukit Batok SCDF Division.

WHAT IS AED AND HOW TO USE IT

The Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is a computerised medical device that is capable of analysing the casualty's heart rhythm and directs the user to deliver an electric shock to the casualty. Upon switching on the AED, the device will read out instructions on how to operate the AED, when to perform CPR and when to deliver a shock to the casualty.



THE AED CANNOT BE USED IF THE CASUALTY IS:

- Responsive or has pulse and/or breathing.
- An infant below one year old.
- Obviously dead.


TO PREPARE THE CASUALTY

- 1** Paste the defibrillation pads onto the casualty's bare chest; tear or cut off any obstructing fabric if necessary.
- 2** Remove/push aside any jewellery or accessories on the casualty's chest. Remove any patches (e.g. medicated patch) if they interfere with the placement of the defibrillation pads.
- 3** Shave excess hair on the casualty's chest to ensure that the defibrillation pads stick well to the skin (Note: There is a shaver in the AED kit).
- 4** Dry the casualty's chest area of any perspiration and moisture as these can reduce contact between the defibrillation pads and the skin.
- 5** If there is any pacemaker, place defibrillation pads four fingers away from the pacemaker. In the meantime, ensure that continuous CPR is performed on the casualty.

APPLY THE DEFIBRILLATION PADS (WITH CPR IN PROGRESS):

- Follow the instructions on the packet and remove the pads.
- Peel off the backing and paste the pads as shown; ensure they are pasted down well with no air pockets.

Follow the AED's voice prompted instructions and perform CPR as required until the ambulance crew arrives or the casualty shows signs of life. Do not touch the casualty while AED is preparing the shock. Once the casualty shows signs of life, check for breathing. If the casualty is not breathing, continue with CPR and use the AED. If the casualty is breathing, monitor his breathing constantly until the ambulance crew arrives.

About 900,000 households will benefit from the rebates.


