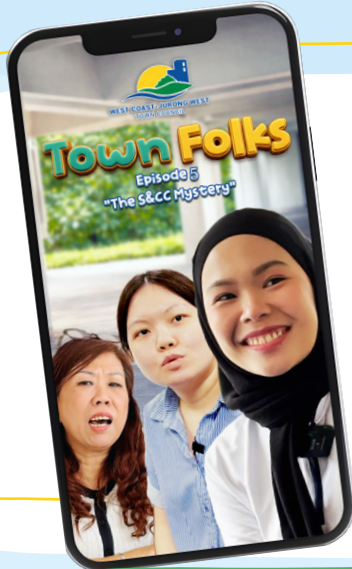
We are truly appreciative of the professionalism and responsiveness shown by the town council team. Keep up the good work!

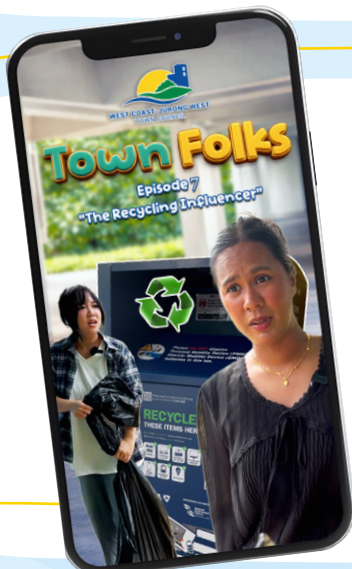
