



BLUEPRINT TO ENHANCE VIBRANCY FOR TEBAN GARDENS HDB SHOPS

A blueprint is in the works to enhance the common areas of the HDB shops at Teban Gardens Road to improve the shopping ambience and to give a competitive boost to attract more shoppers.

The 59 shops located at Block 37 to 39 and Block 61 Teban Gardens will be upgraded under the Revitalisation of Shops (ROS) Scheme, to enhance the living and shopping environment for both residents and retailers.

Shop owners can look forward to enhancements such as drop down blinds, LED lights and more prominent signages at the shop front. For sold shops, owners have to pay 20% of the total cost which will be capped at \$5000, while the ROS cost for rental shops will be fully funded by HDB and Town Council.



RESIDENTS JOG AND CYCLE ON NEW EXERCISE TRACK

Gear up with a pair of running shoes or rollerblades or simply get on a bicycle to kick start a healthy lifestyle! West Coast residents now have an extra incentive to exercise, keep healthy and socialise with friends and their friendly neighbours. Suggested by residents and supported by Minister S Iswaran, the 600-metres track runs from Block 601 to 610 Clementi West Street 1 and was officially opened by Mr Iswaran on 21 August 2016.

NEW HOMES FOR WEST COAST ROAD RESIDENTS

Residents of Block 513 to 520 West Coast Road can look forward to their “new home” in 2022 as the precinct is selected for the Selective En Bloc Redevelopment Scheme (SERS).

Residents can choose their new homes from two replacement sites in Clementi Town. Site A at Clementi Avenue 1 offers 680 units and Site B at West Coast Link offers 666 units. The two sites offer over 1,300 flats with a mix of 2-room, 3-room, 4-room, 5-room, and 3-Gen units. The new flats are expected to be completed in 2022.

In his announcement to residents, Mr S Iswaran, Adviser to West Coast Grassroots Organisations, said: “Under SERS, you will receive the market value of your flat as compensation and be able to buy a new replacement flat with a fresh 99 year lease at HDB’s subsidised price.”

Together with the upgrading of West Coast Community Centre, the ABC Waters Programme along Sungei Pandan Kechil, and the new HDB flats at West Coast Link, residents can look forward to an endearing home and quality living environment.

Lift Rescue Procedure

1 Upon receipt of telephone call from public or passenger trapped in the lift, or signal received by the Tele-monitoring System arising from the pressing of the alarm button, the lift rescue team will be deployed to attend to the case.

2 When the Lift Rescue Operators (LRO) arrived at the block, the 1st LRO will first check the level where the lift has stalled.

3 The LRO will communicate with the trapped passengers and seek their patience while the lift rescue operation is carried out.

4 The LRO will then proceed to the lift motor room to turn-off the main switch and Automatic Rescue Device (ARD) to prevent the lift from accidental movement.

5 The 2nd LRO will standby at the nearest lift lobby where the lift is stalled at.

6 If the lift car is levelled with the landing, the 2nd LRO will open the lift door to release the trapped passengers.

7 If the lift car is not levelled with the landing eg. jammed between 2 storeys, the 1st LRO will manually wind up the lift to the next floor.


8 Once the lift and landing is levelled, the 2nd LRO will open the lift doors to release the trapped passengers.

9 In a situation where the lift rescue is beyond the rescue team's capability, eg. Lift brakes or lift doors jammed, the LRO will request for lift company's assistance.

10 The LROs will wait for the lift company's staff to arrive. The lift company's staff will take over the lift rescue.


