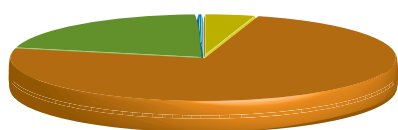

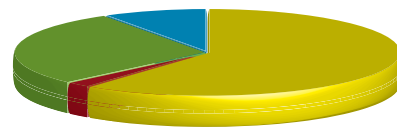


Income & Expenditure for FY18/19

Town Council Funds at 31 March 2019

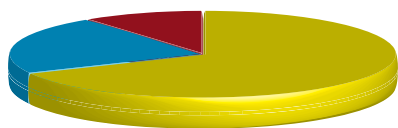

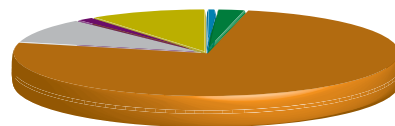

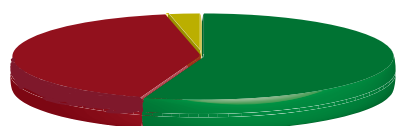

Sinking Fund Expenditure for FY18/19



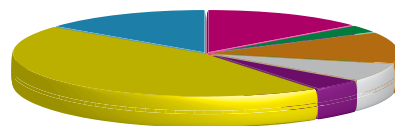

West Coast Town Council gets an **all-green** Report Card

West Coast TC has received a 'green' report card for the period April 2018 to March 2019. The results of the Town Council Management Report (TCMR) released by the Ministry of National Development (MND), where all town councils are assessed on five indicators, using three colour bands – green, amber and red – with green indicating the best results.

We received the green mark for all the five indicators. This effort is achieved with the support and co-operation of our residents and grassroots organisations. We look forward to the continued collaboration with all our residents and grassroots organisations to ensure that West Coast Town will always be "home sweet home" for all.
