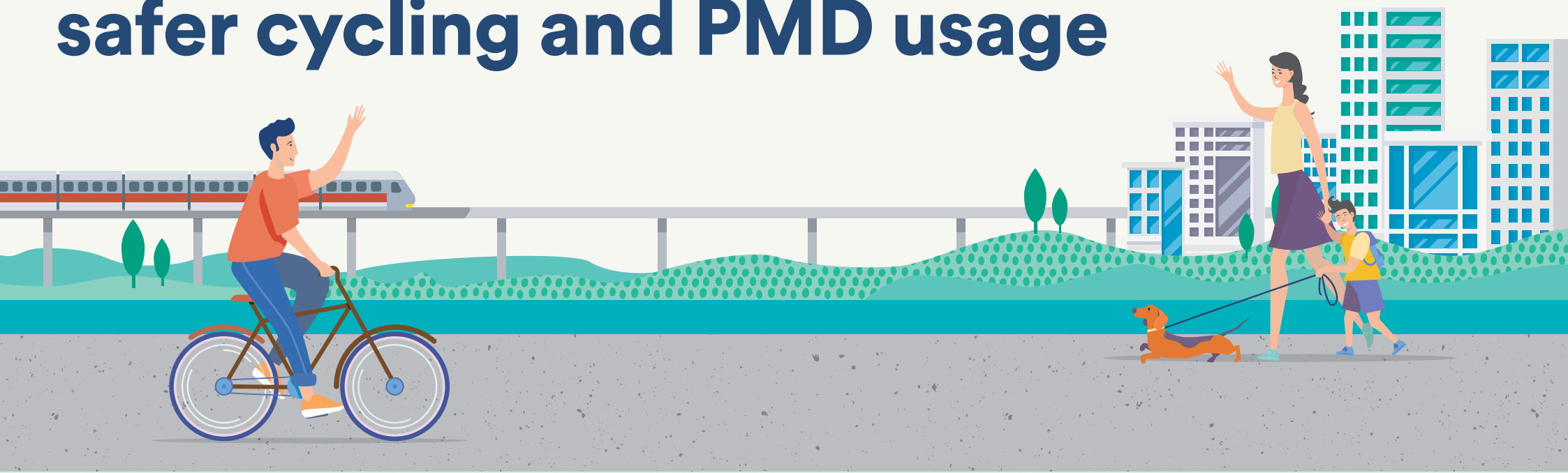


4 new rules to note for safer cycling and PMD usage



1 Unless supervised by adults, those under 16 years of age cannot ride an e-scooter on cycling paths



Penalties for first offence:
Up to \$1,000 fine and/or 3 months jail time

3 Use only UL2272 PMDs on cycling paths



Penalties for first offence:
Up to \$10,000 fine and/or 6 months jail time

2 Do not use mobile phone while riding on paths and roads



Penalties for first offence:
Up to \$1,000 fine and/or 3 months jail time (on paths)
Up to \$1,000 fine and/or 6 months jail time (on roads)

4 Do not perform illegal modifications on your active mobility devices

Devices used on public paths have to comply with the device criteria found on <https://go.gov.sg/amrules>



Penalties for first offence:
Up to \$20,000 fine and/or 24 months jail time
