Trees for the Future

AYER RAJAH-GEK POH

Tree Planting Day took place on 6 November 2022 where 10 *Garcinia subellipticas* were planted at Block 411 Pandan Gardens and Block 273A Jurong West Avenue 3. Known as the “Happiness Tree”, Ms Foo Mee Har, MP for West Coast GRC (Ayer Rajah-Gek Poh), hoped the new trees would “bring an abundance of happiness to our residents”. During the event, residents also joined in the neighbourhood litter-picking exercise and an appreciation ceremony was held for our cleaners.

West Coast GRC and Pioneer SMC continue to get greener by the day! Thirty one young trees were planted in our GRC in the month of November 2022 as part of the annual Tree Planting Day. West Coast residents joined in the tradition and contributed towards building a town flourishing with greenery. Here is how Tree Planting went down in each division:

TELOK BLANGAH

It’s never too early to start! Residents as young as one joined Ms Rachel Ong, MP for West Coast GRC (Telok Blangah), for Tree Planting on 5 November 2022 at Block 1 Dover Road. Together, they planted five *Garcinia subellipticas* despite the persistent drizzle. The event also took the opportunity to honour dedicated cleaners from the Town Council and recognised eight cleanest blocks across Depot, Dover, and Telok Blangah estates.

BOON LAY

Boon Lay division celebrated Tree Planting on 5 November 2022 by planting five critically endangered tree species — the *Sea Tristania* and Derum Bukit (*Cratoxylum maingayi*) — at Block 667D Jurong West Street 65. Mr Desmond Lee, MP for West Coast GRC (Boon Lay), was joined by residents, Edusave award winners, partners from AkzoNobel and NParks representatives in planting these precious trees in the estate.



NANYANG

Despite the rain, residents were resolute in joining Mr Ang Wei Neng, MP for West Coast GRC (Nanyang), for Tree Planting on 19 November 2022 at Block 980 Jurong West Street 93. With the 50 young saplings of the *Cratoxylum maingayi* species recently planted, Nanyang is getting closer to their goal of planting 1,000 trees in the division!



Thumbs Up for Community First Responders

Together, we can keep everyone safe and secure! This key message went out to all residents at AR-GP's Community Resilience Day on Oct 20. MP Foo Mee Har thanked those who have signed up as Community First Responders. "To date, I understand that over 120,000 people have registered on the myResponder app, and they have responded to about half of all cases on the app." She also urged residents to attend training sessions to pick up life-savings skills like simple first aid, how to use a fire extinguisher, perform CPR and use an AED.


