Will it rain or will it be blazing hot today? Worse, perhaps thunder and storms? Forecasting the weather will soon be a thing of the past for Pioneer residents.

A solution is within sight to allow residents, come rain or shine, to move with relative ease and convenience, within Pioneer Constituency. Yes, our Barrier Free Access project will be a reality in the near future!

Grassroots Adviser Mr Patrick Tay, BBM shared that in recent times, due to climate change, storms and strong winds are becoming more frequent in Singapore. He proposed a "connectivity route map" in Pioneer Constituency to show residents how to navigate, on foot, with BFA and sheltered link access to reach their venues or homes during erratic weather. While BFA will benefit all residents, it will be of particular significance for certain groups of residents like the elderly and those who are disabled or with medical conditions.

Parents with babies in strollers or toddlers in hand will be rest assured their little ones will be properly sheltered from the elements of weather.

Site checks are currently being conducted to identify the specific spots for the "Connectivity Mapping Route" in Pioneer Constituency. They will include the connecting route provided by LTA to major transportation modes (MRT, Bus-Interchange, Bus-Stop).

Operating details are being finalised and the project is expected to launch in the near future.
